



# GM Membership: Important SUB Update

For several weeks, GM, Unifor National and Unifor Local 222 have been in discussions to resolve to the issues surrounding SUB, CERB, EI-ERB. The three parties have had numerous meetings with various government officials and industry stakeholders to try and attain SUB payments for members eligible under the terms of the current Collective Agreement.

**The parties have now reached an agreement.** Over the next few weeks, GM will begin to process Return To Work (RTW) lump sum payments for members who were ineligible to receive a SUB benefit during their temporary layoff, due to the receipt of CERB or EI-ERB.

RTW payments will be processed **only when an employee returns to work on active status.** Based on recall from layoff, not all team members will receive RTW payments at the same time and the amounts will vary based on individual circumstances. Members will also be required to provide information regarding the payments they have received from the Government in order to ensure correct calculation.

Any team member who has retired, thus not returning to active status, will still be entitled to the payment. We will work on these on an individual basis.

The COVID pandemic has caused many changes in our day-to-day dealings. We would like to thank everyone for their patience during this process, as we fully understand it has been very difficult for you and your families.
