



Save Oshawa GM UPDATE

Arbitration: We now have tentative dates for our arbitration case in front of Arbitrator Robert Herman. These dates are May 23, 24 and 29. We are still awaiting confirmation of these dates by the Company.

Preliminary Talks: We can confirm that there are meetings with the Company in an effort to resolve our present situation. We completely understand our location's diverse demographics and will work hard to exceed our entitlement in accordance with the Collective Agreement. We continue to try to maintain a footprint in Oshawa, while General Motors has not changed its position of no future vehicles to replace our present models.

Build-out Dates: The tentative build-out dates provided by the Company have Flex building out the beginning of October and Truck building out on two shifts the beginning of December.

Mental Health: The Company has committed to have on-site professional counsellors to provide help for our members by the end of March. This help will be available before and after shift. Summer Shutdown Dates: The annual plant shutdown is scheduled for the first two weeks in July, which are the weeks starting July 1 and July 8. Anyone wishing to have additional weeks off should do so by April 15 on a Vacation Leave of Absence form. Make sure you keep a copy of this form for your records.

Any members wishing to allocate vacation pay to additional weeks must do so in 40-hour increments (Monday-Friday) following the vacation shutdown, if sufficient hours are available. You need to apply on a Vacation Deferral form. There will be 80 hours of our vacation pay allocated to the weeks of Monday, July 1 and Monday, July 8, 2019. Vacation pay deferral requests are irrevocable.




